# NEEP's Goal of Residential Lighting Market Transformation



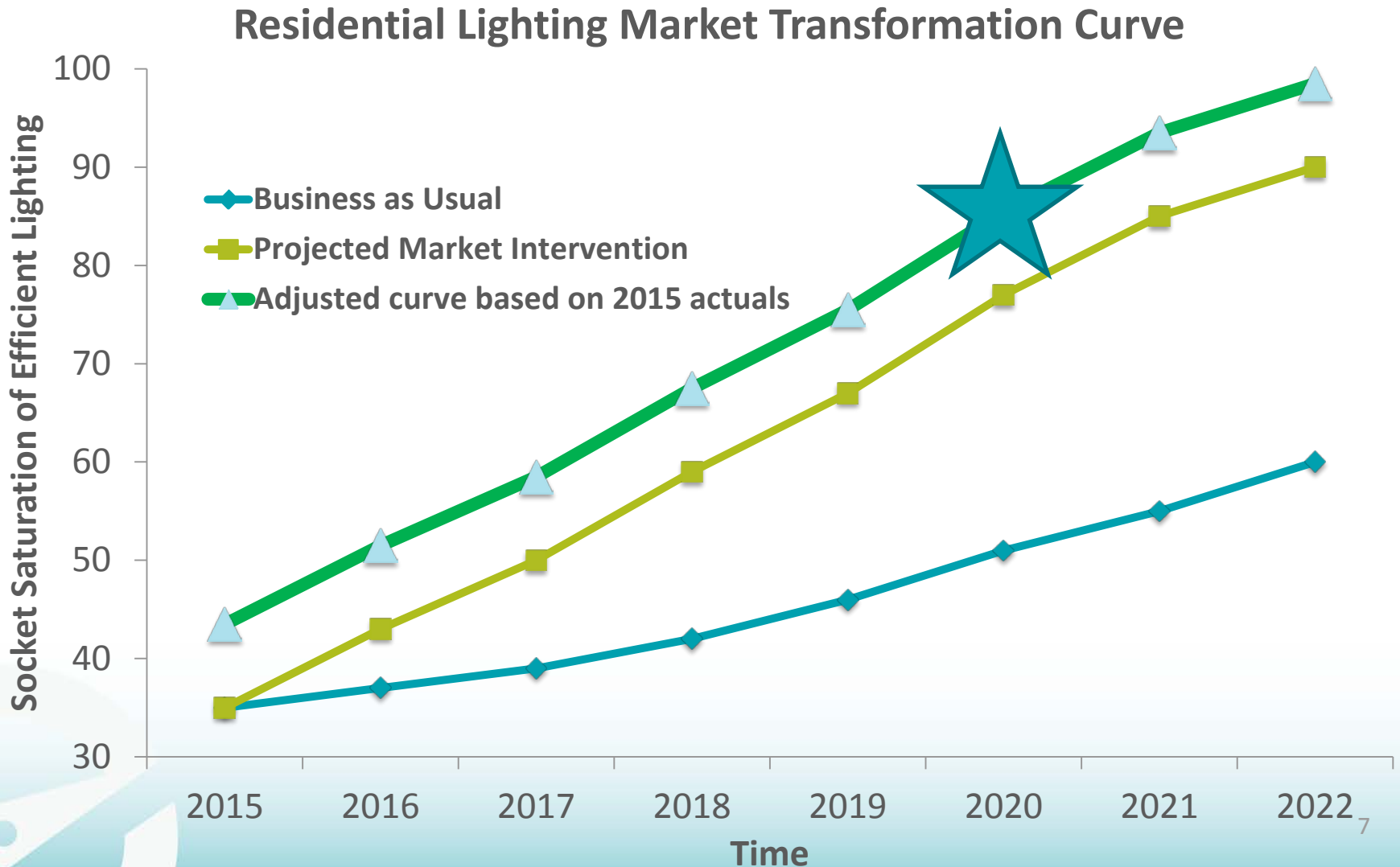
Goal: The residential lighting market should be able to reach a socket saturation of 80-90 percent efficient quality lighting when transformed.
