




#### **Green Communities Designation and Grant Program**

#### **Established by the Green Communities Act of 2008**

#### **Designation Criteria**

- Adopt as-of-right siting for renewable/alternative energy generation, research and development, or manufacturing
- Adopt expedited permitting process
- 3. Create an energy use baseline and a plan to reduce municipal energy use by 20% in 5 years
- 4. Purchase only fuel-efficient vehicles
- 5. Reduce life-cycle costs of new construction by adopting the stretch energy code



#### **Eligible for Grants on Municipal Property**

- Energy efficiency projects
- Renewable energy projects




- On average, vehicles account for ~ 16% of energy in municipal operations
  - > Smaller communities can be 60%+

- Electrical prices are stable (or, at least, historically more so than gasoline)
- Cleaner option (air quality, GHG emissions) that will become even cleaner over time




Vehicle	2023 Ford Mustang Gasoline	2023 Ford Mustang MACH-E
