Adopted by the Steering Committee in December 2010.

Provide state-level reporting templates for electric and natural gas EE program energy and demand savings and associated costs, and their emission and job impacts.

Reflect what most jurisdictions would find feasible to report without making significant changes to current reporting practices.

If implemented, the region would benefit from common currency of reported energy efficiency data to support state and regional energy and environmental policies and objectives.

- A follow-up 2011 Forum project will support the implementation of the Reporting Guidelines by:
 - Developing an online tool that will allow states to readily use the Guidelines' reporting tables.
 - Providing supporting technical assistance for use of the online reporting tool.
 - Facilitating Forum region intra-state agency and program administrator coordination to support consistent reporting of avoided air emissions and air quality planning associated with efficiency programs.
