Completed and adopted by the Steering Committee in May 2010. Provide clarity, transparency, and a common understanding of methods to consider in determining gross energy and demand savings, and savings assumptions for a priority set of energy efficiency program types or measures.

Provide cross-cutting and measure specific recommendations that are applicable to fourteen measures/programs, covering topics such as rigor, site inspections and measure life determination. Identify and define common and consistent methods for preliminary savings; gross and net evaluated savings; measure baseline, life, and persistence; and strategies for dealing with uncertainty/rigor.
